

Amateur Spotlight - Rules and Entry

All artworks must be family-appropriate and may not contain images of violence, profanity, obscenity, or inflammatory material (political, religious, etc.). Lakeside Arts Foundation reserves the right to reject entries for any reason including, but not limited to use of inappropriate subject matter.

Photos of artwork may be posted on the Chalk This Way Facebook page at the close of the festival and posted online and in the local print media following the event.

Board members of Visual Art League or board members of Lakeside Arts Foundation and immediate family members of the board of directors are ineligible for any contest prizes but may participate in the exhibition only (non-judged) areas.

Other than chalk, which is provided by LAF, artists must provide their own supplies and materials.

Artists are encouraged to wear sunscreen, sun-protective clothing, closed-toe shoes, and a hat. You may also bring an umbrella or small canopy to cover your art, but the canopy must be removed when the artwork is completed. Do not wear clothing that you do not want to risk being stained or ruined. Chalk art is messy.

By entering this activity, the artist gives LAF permission to photograph and publish me and my artwork.

Liability Release: I acknowledge the risks and assume personal responsibility for my actions during this outdoor event. I hereby release, covenant not to sue and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Lakeside Arts Foundation and its agents, officers, employees, volunteers and successors from any claim or liability, which I, my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns may have or claim to have arising out of any bodily injury, death, or property damage I might sustain relating to activities while participating in Chalk This Way Sidewalk Chalk Art Festival.
